Water System Upgrade

The Town of Troutville voted to spend approximately 2+ million dollars to upgrade the main water line along Route 11 in Troutville.

The Town received bids thru September 6, and the bid was awarded to E.C. Pace Company of Roanoke. The contract was signed on October 19, 2012 with a total price of \$1,880,510.00.

The Contractor has started working on the project and work will be completed within 270 days. They will work through the winter as weather permits.
